SUMMARY

The General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 entered into force on 24 May 2016. The Regulation shall apply from 25 May 2018 in all member states of the European Union.

The protection of personal data is a fundamental right in the European Union. The purpose of the General Data Protection Regulation is to enable natural persons to get better control of their personal data by providing them right of access, right to rectification, right to erasure, right to restriction of processing, right to data portability and right to information on personal data breach.

The purpose of the study is to ascertain whether and to what extent The General Data Protection Regulation will have an impact on land surveying in Finland.
