

- **Impactful** and constant activity to update in the field of **spatial information management**, thus succeeding in achieving important universally shared objectives.



















Key messages

- Need to establish long-term sustainable land administration systems based on legal frameworks and political commitment rather than implementing projects with short-term success
- Land management in growing urban zones including acquisition of data from smart devices
- bringing existing infrastructures to a more secure level of operation (cloud, blockchain)
- impact of land registration on real estate markets and on value of land
- Improvement of quality of data and services by integration of user communities
- legal, technical and social security of tenure and systems to be developed and connected





- The highlight of the workshop was a visit to the New Istanbul Airport where BIM is used.
























Key focus area (C1):


