




BACKGROUND OF LAND CONSOLIDATION

- Land reallocation falls under inventory and planning stage.




LAND CONSOLIDATION AND CUSTOMARY LANDS






FRAMEWORK FOR A LAND REALLOCATION APPROACH






LAND REALLOCATION REQUIREMENTS







CUSTOMARY LANDS






LAND REALLOCATION PROCESS MODEL




- Three key land tenure types.
