 - 10. Construction Economics and Management




FIG Young Surveyors Network

 - Collaborate with other likeminded industries and professions.






Our Vision

- Involve FIG Commission at Young Surveyors Events.








Working Group 2.3 – Learning Styles in Surveying Education

 - Build upon the "Invest in Yourself" Workshop during YSN meetings and conferences.








- Aim:
