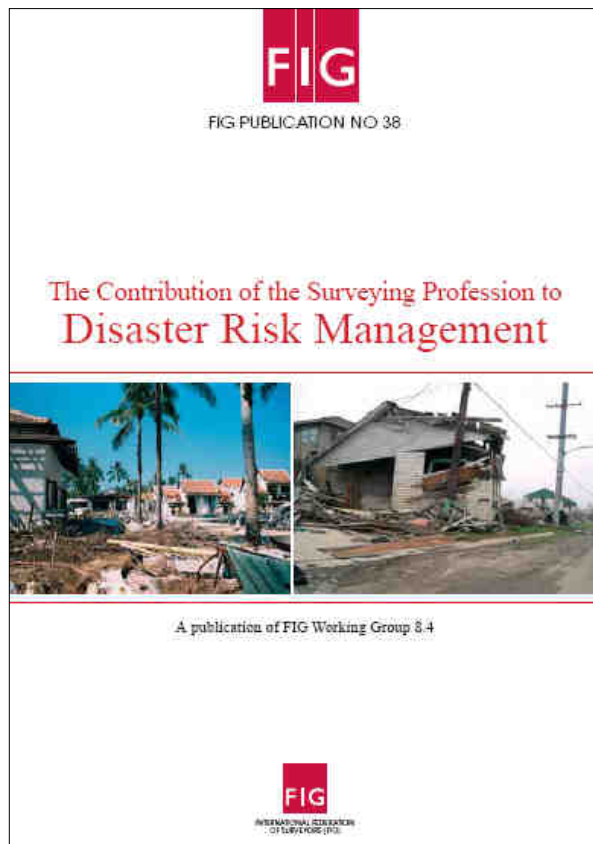

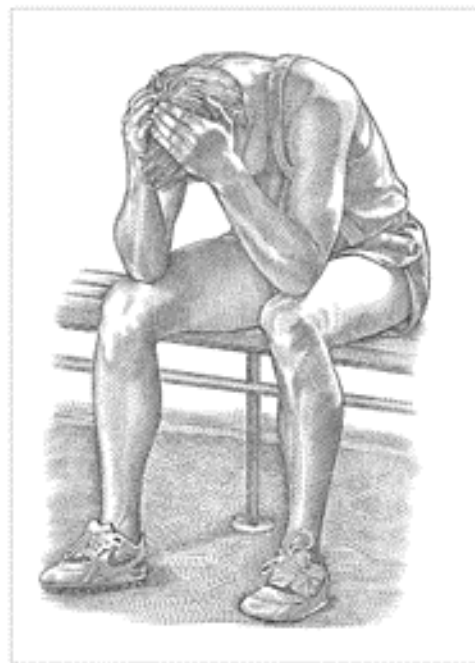

Seminar on State and Public Land Management will be organised in Verona, Italy, September 9-10, 2008, just before the FIG Commission 7 Annual Meeting. FIG Commission 3 (Spatial Information Management)

Introduction

Current cadastral registrations use 2D parcel law restrictions on land. In most cases this is of real estate. But in cases of multiple use of traditional 2D cadastre is not, or only in a limited way, those rights in the third dimension.

At the FIG-congress in April 2002 in Washington, DC, the Commission 3 was established in order to study the 3D issue of cadastral registration at the national level.

This working group on 3D Cadastres is a joint effort of the Commission 3 of the International Federation of Surveyors (FIG) (as part of Working Group 7.3 (Advanced Land Administration Systems)).

Aim

The working group aims to publish a publication on the legal, institutional and technical issues.
